Alex, the main character in a story, is very forgetful.

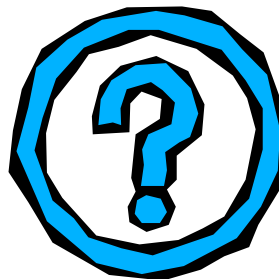
Character
