Dear Parents/Carers

Year 3 Pine Class- Swimming at Medway Park

As part of the National Physical Education Curriculum, Year 3 will be swimming every Friday commencing Friday 26th March 2019 to Friday 19th July 2019. There will be a total of 12 swimming sessions taking into account term dates and access to the pool.

Each child will be fully supervised at the pool by teachers and trained lifeguards and will receive a programme of instruction according to their level of ability.

We do not charge for the cost of swimming instruction, however we do require a Parent Mail payment towards the cost of transport. This can be paid as a one off payment of £30.00 or by 2 instalments of £15.00 via the online ParentMail or by bar code request that can be used at any paypoint store. The school is no longer accepting cash payments.

Swimming is now a compulsory part of the National Curriculum and children will only be excused with a valid note from Parents.
