Dear Parents/Carers,

Welcome to Twydall's first Inclusion newsletter! My name is Miss Roscoe and I joined Twydall in January 2022. I would like to start our first newsletter by taking the opportunity to introduce you to the Inclusion Team.



My name is Miss Roscoe and I am Assistant Head Teacher and Inclusion Manager. I oversee the day-to-day operation of our SEND policy and support with identification of children with special educational needs. I also co-ordinate provision for children with SEN and liaise with children, parents and carers about their children's needs and progress. If you have any concerns about your child, please arrange to meet with me!

My name is Mrs Deasey and I am the Home School Support Worker. I support children and families in a variety of ways. I am able to support families with advice around parenting, behaviour support, Food Bank referrals and signposting to a range of services. I am also a trained Play Therapist and am able to offer Play Therapy sessions, along with a range of other interventions to support children's wellbeing.



My name is Mrs Busby and I am the Pastoral Co-ordinator. I work closely with children to support their social, emotional and mental health needs. I offer social skills and wellbeing support through a range of strategies and interventions, one of which is through the use of the ELSA programme. I am a trained HLTA and also teach a range of lessons across the school.

Next week is **World Autism Acceptance Week** and we will be exploring this within class and assembly. 1 in 100 children are diagnosed with the condition and we are really proud to be an inclusive school who strives to meet the needs of all learners.
