Our Learning Overview

An Overview of Europe

English

In Writing, we will be writing a character description based on our book, The Miraculous Journey of Edward Tulane. We will be learning how to use a wide range of interesting vocabulary, use noun phrases and use 'show not tell' in our writing.

Maths

We will be spending time learning multiplication and division. We will need to know multiplication and division facts up to 12×12 . We will also learn how to multiply a 2 or 3 digit number by a 1 digit number. Finally, we will learn how to divide a 2 or 3 digit number by a 1 digit number with remainders in our answer too.

Science

Animals including humans is our topic in Science. We will be looking at different teeth and their functions, food chains as well as the human digestive system and how food travels through our bodies.

Computing

In Computing, we will be making logos using code. We will be learning how to insert code so that the software can draw our intended logo.

Geography

In Geography, we will be learning about Europe. The children will be looking how to locate European countries using an atlas. We will also be looking at important features around Europe, learning key vocabulary about climate and time zones.

RE

In RE, we will be looking at the question 'How does Jesus' treatment of outcasts speak to Christians today?'. We will learn about the historical context of Jesus, analyse key stories and learn how Jesus associated himself with others.

Art

In Art, the children will be learning about the Vietnamese artist, Tran Nguyen. We will use her ideas to inspire our own piece of art.

Music

In Music, our topic is 'Musical Contrasts'. We will be grouping instruments on their families and sounds and exploring different timbres.

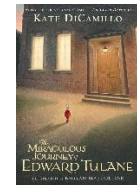
PSHE
