Our Learning Overview

Kenya

English

Our text this term will be "Lila and the Secret of Rain". This beautiful story book is based in Kenya. We will be using this as inspiration to write an information text about Kenya. We will also be learning how to read a variety of texts and then answer different styles of comprehension questions.

Maths

We will be continuing our learning about multiplication and division, understanding what they mean and how to use them in our calculations. We will be using the 2s, 5s and 10 times tables. We will be working with measures such as length, height, weight, capacity and temperature.

Science

This term we are focussing on British Science Week 2026 and the theme of "Curiosity: What is your question?" We will have lots of hands-on investigations and we will be encouraging the children to be curious and ask their own questions.

Computing

In Term 4, we will be learning about how to do safe and effective searches online and on websites such as Purple Mash. We will also be using Purple Mash to create our own pictures on the computers, selecting and using a variety of different tools.

Geography

We will be finding out about physical and human features in Kenya and deciding on whether we might like to visit there. We will be learning how to use atlases to find the names of seas and oceans around the UK and the world.

RE

We will be exploring the question, "Do we need rules to live?". We will look at what rules are and why we have them, then considering some religious points of view such as from Christianity and Humanism.

Music

We will be continuing our learning how emotions link to music and responding to different pieces of music through words and pictures.

DT

We will be learning how to do a running stitch and using this skill when we design and make our own flags, using traditional African shapes and colours for our inspiration.

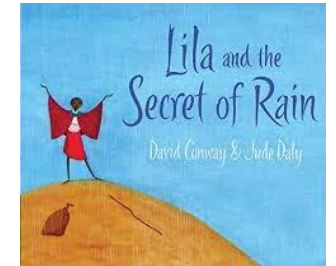
PSHE

In our lessons with Jigsaw Jo, our topic for this term is "Healthy Me". We will be thinking about our physical and mental health, including the importance of a healthy diet, exercise and relaxing, and the importance of using medicines correctly and safely.

PE

Our indoor PE lessons will be gymnastics. We will be learning how to link movements between and on the apparatus. During our outdoor PE lessons we will be learning about jumping. Pupils will explore jumping using different combinations, jumping for distance and speeds and when we jump in different games.
