Our Learning Overview

The First Flight

English

Children will continue to take part in daily phonics lessons and will apply their developing phonics knowledge across their learning. Children will be learning to write a simple biography about Queen Elizabeth II. Children will also be learning how to write a letter to inform.

Maths

Children will be continuing to learn how to add and subtract within 20. We will then learn about numbers up to 50, solidifying our knowledge on tens and ones in a number. Children will be learning about mass and volume, and length and height, using different equipment to measure.

Science

During this term, we will be celebrating National Science Week, where our topic is called Curious Chemistry. We will be showing our curiosity and asking questions.

Computing

Children will be creating an animated story based around Queen Elizabeth II.

History

Children will be learning about Queen Elizabeth II and how important she was during her 70 years as a Monarch. The children will be learning about democracy and how Queen Elizabeth II made an impact on society.

RE

Children will be learning how stories can inspire actions and encourage people to be kind. We will be looking at Christianity and Islam.

DT

Children will be learning the technical aspects of a moving picture. They will be designing their own moving picture before creating their own picture.

PSHE

Children will be learning about how to be healthy and making healthy choices. We will be learning about road safety and medicine safety.

PE

In PE, children will be learning Dance, focusing on how to combine individual movements to create a complete dance sequence. During outdoor PE sessions, they will develop their gross motor skills through jumping and how to jump safely.
