Our Learning Overview

The Mayans

English

In Writing, we will be writing a persuasive letter based on the characters and events of our class book, The Lost Happy Endings. The children will be learning to use a variety of persuasive techniques, write coherently using paragraphs, write in the first person and use many conjunctions in their work.

Maths

We will be spending time learning place value up to 10,000. We need to know what each digit represents in a number and different ways of splitting numbers up. We will also be rounding numbers to the nearest 10, 100 and 1000.

Science

Sound is our topic in Science. We will be looking at what sound is, how sound travels through solids, liquids and gases and comparing the pitches of different objects. We will also be conducting experiments on finding patterns between the volume and strength of vibrations.

Computing

In Computing, we will be coders. We will be learning how to design and create an interactive scene.

History

In History, we will be learning about the Mayans. The children will be looking at the home life of the Mayans. Specifically what their houses were like, how they dressed and how they entertained themselves.

RE

In RE, we will be looking at the question 'How does Guru Nanak inspire Sikhs today?'. We will learn about Guru Nanak's teachings, how Sikhs serve others and how they lead a good life.

Art

In Art, the children will be learning about the Pop-artist, Roy Lichtenstein. We will use his ideas to inspire our own piece of art.

Music

In Music, our topic is 'Playing with Rhythm'. We will be constructing our own pieces of music using a variety of instruments with the focus centred around keeping a rhythm together.

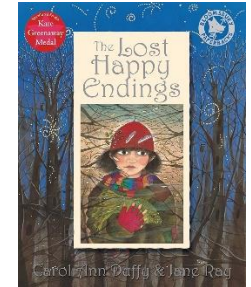
PSHE
