### Our Learning Overview

#### English

In English, we will be learning how to sit correctly at the table to write, how to write on the line, using finger spaces and writing captions. We will be exploring our key texts by evaluating illustrations and role playing, considering how our characters are feeling. We will be learning to understand and recognise an adjective and applying it within our writing.

#### Maths

In Maths, we will be understanding place value of number 0-10 by working out 1 more and 1 less, comparing numbers using less than, greater than and equal to. Lessons will be carried out in fun and practical activities. We will be ordering objects and numbers, using a number line. We will be looking at part-whole models and how we can use part-whole models to write addition and subtraction number sentences.

#### Science

In Science, we will be learning about our bodies and our five senses. Our learning will take place in the outdoors in co-ordination with The Harmony Project. We will be using vocabulary linked to our smell, sight, hearing, touch and taste.

#### Computing

In Computing, we will be learning about the features of a computer and how to use and respect our equipment. The children will be learning how to log onto the computer and how to navigate around a computer, using a mouse and keyboard.

#### Geography

In Geography, we will be learning about the United Kingdom and the four countries, as well as the capital cities. We will be comparing the local area to the countryside, by observing our environments and creating pictograms to compare. We will be looking at the physical features of London as a city.

#### RE

In RE, we will be learning about ourselves and how we belong.

#### Art

In Art, we will be researching Sam Gillian as an artist. We will be experimenting with the techniques she used and recreating our own pieces of art in the style of Sam Gillian.

#### PSHE

In PSHE, we will be looking at our school expectations, how to be a good person, and how to be safe. We will be learning about our class, rights and responsibilities and rewards and feeling proud.

#### PE

In PE, we will be taking part in teamwork activities to understand how important teamwork is as part of a team. In our outdoor PE, we will be learning how to run safely and in different directions, at different speeds.
